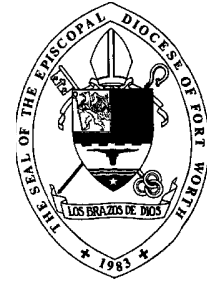


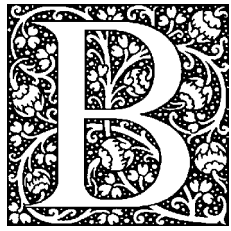

BELOVED in Christ,

The journey we began last February with Ash Wednesday; has come to its conclusion with the Feasts of Pentecost and Trinity Sunday. The territory we covered through Lent and Easter has drawn us closer to the heart of our faith, the mystery of our redemption, through the person and work of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
